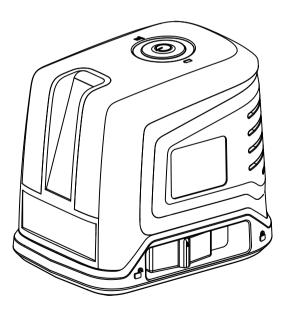

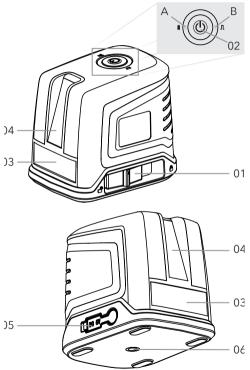

# **SAFETY**

Please read the complete safety instructions in the booklet delivered with this device.

Use extreme caution when the laser beam is turned on.

Do not aim the laser beam at any gas that may explode.

LASER RADIATION - Class 2 Laser product. - Do not stare into beam.

## **BATTERY**

Build-in 3.7V Li-ion battery (2600 mAh)

When the [A] Power LED starts flashing, the battery is running low.

# **FIRST TIME USAGE**

Remove all protection foils.

# **USE**

#### AUTO-LEVELLING



Slide the ON/OFF / Pendulum Lock switch [01] to the ON side. The power LED indicator [A] will light up. The pendulum levelling mechanism is released, and the instrument will align on its own.



The Horizontal laser line will light up. Make sure that the instrument is placed on a flat surface with a maximum slope of 4°.



If the slope exceeds 4°, the laser lines will start blinking.

#### SLOPE MODE



To work in manual slope mode, the pendulum needs to be locked. Make sure the ON/OFF / Pendulum Lock switch [01] is in the OFF position.

Switch on the device by holding the Horizontal laser line / Power button [02] for approx. 3 sec. until the laser switches ON.

#### \_\_ MANUAL SLOPE



 Now you can manually tilt the laser using a tripod with a tilting head to get the exact desired slope.

#### NOTE

In slope mode, the laser lines no longer levelled automatically. A slow flashing warning indicator [F] will remind you the pendulum is blocked and the laser is not able to level.

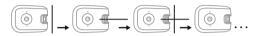
We advise to use a slope adapter (optional) or tripod with tilting head (optional) to set slopes.

# SWITCHING ON/OFF LASER LINES

When switching on the device, the horizontal laser diode will be activated.

#### HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LASER LINES

When the laser is turned on, only the horizontal laser line will be active.



- Press the Power button [02] once to activate the vertical laser line. The horizontal laser line will be deactivated.
- Press the Power button [02] again to reactivate the horizontal laser line. Both horizontal and vertical laser lines are now active.
- · Press the Power button [02] a third time to deactivate both laser lines.
- · Press the Power button [02] a fourth time to reactivate the horizontal laser line.
- · ... (these four previous steps will repeat).

# NOTE

We advise to set the horizontal line on your working height, using a tripod.

#### ■ RECEIVER MODE

When working in a bright environment (e.g. outdoors) or over longer distances, laser lines become less visible to the human eye. To find the laser lines in those situations, this laser can be used with a laser receiver.



- · To activate the Receiver mode, press the receiver mode button [02]. The receiver mode LED indicator [B] will light up and you will notice the activated laser lines decrease slightly in brightness. In receiver mode, the laser line will start blinking very fast (pulse at 10KHz) to allow the laser receiver, which operates by pulsed light, to detect the laser line.
- · To deactivate the receiver mode, press the Receiver mode button [02] again. The receiver mode LED indicator [B] turns off and the brightness of the active laser lines will increase again.

## NOTE

All Futech lasers will use 10Khz as frequency in receiver mode. Only receivers that can detect laser lines at 10KHz are compatible.
